Support use of recorded lectures

Record lectures

Record all my lectures

Try and ensure recording of lectures remains

Offer multiple ways/platforms for learners to demonstrate their knowledge.

always check online resources for accessibility

try and use software with a subtitle option for live teaching if at all possible

Make sure captions are available and recordings too and LISTEN and take their concerns seriously!

Push for more recording of lectures

What one thing will you do into the future to ensure inclusivity in your teaching & learning?

Always having a recorded lecture

Closed captions/live transcriptions.

Ask students what they need / would value to support inclusivity, ease of access

Ensure that student's with disabilities are taken into consideration and their specific needs prioritised when considering how modules will be delivered in the future.

I am completing my UDL badge

Continue making all lecture material available to students in our virtual learning platform. I will consider the value or pre-recorded material to certain students within the class depending on their circumstances, making those available to them.

Promote UDL

Ask first what is the student's best way of expressing themselves in exams. If writing, speaking, and so on.

Provide choices - e.g. online or face to face, digital and paper version, to suit the needs of students

What one thing will you do into the future to ensure inclusivity in your teaching & learning?

Asking students what they want and need upfront. Providing choice in the ways content can be presented.

Look up available tools e.g guides, specifications, models, taxonomies ... which might help . Or, ask is there a needs for more guidelines, tools

Ask the class if there is something that I could do that would be helpful, try to ensure that they are aware that I am happy for feedback (good & bad). Keep the lines of communication open

Remember to set up closed captions properly.

Captions

Make slides fully inclusive. This is not as easy as it should be if you are recycling old slides. The feedback you get from PowerPoint and VLEs like Blackboard is not as helpful as it should be.
